- Promoting research programs which focus on issues relating to rural General Practice

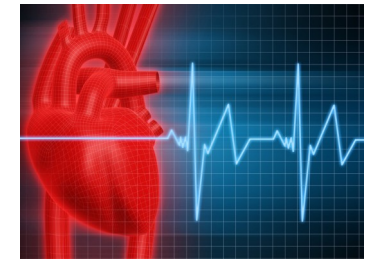

The Heart Health Register

What is the Heart Health Register ?

The aim of the Heart Health Register is to improve cardiac health and help lower the risks of cardiac disease.

The Register is designed to:

- offer you an opportunity for regular assessments of your cardiac condition and risk factors.
- offer a recall/reminder service.

It is most important to assess and review your heart health, lifestyle practices and treatment on an ongoing basis. Changes to risk factor management are often essential to prevent the progress of cardiovascular disease and further cardiac events.

How does the Register work?

- When your next cardiac review is due, your previous test results will be mailed to you with a reminder to make an appointment with your GP.
- NEDGP will continue to maintain your cardiac history and remind you when reviews are necessary.
- All cardiac reviews are carried out by your own GP.
- Intervals between your cardiac reviews will be determined by your GP.
